5 Key Points When Using Pod-Ceal



1. Pod-Ceal will resist wash-off by rain.
2. Apply Pod-Ceal at least one hour during daylight and before an anticipated rain. Daylight for this period is needed for Pod-Ceal to set.
3. There is no need to add other wetters/spreaders to Pod-Ceal.
4. Add Pod-Ceal last to the spray tank as it is filling, with the agitator running. It is generally best to add dry materials to the tank first, and after they are thoroughly mixed and the tank is almost full, add the Pod-Ceal last. For best results always premix Pod-Ceal with water to ensure good emulsification prior to adding to the spray tank.
5. As with most spray applications it is best to rinse the tank, lines and nozzles with water immediately after spraying. If spray deposits have dried in the spray tank then a solvent based cleaning product is required. Such products include Shell Dobatex Gold, Castrol QB100 Cold Water Surf, CT18 or kerosene. See label for further cleaning instructions.
